Call for PhD studies

1. The Department of Biology, University of Crete (UoC), is warmly inviting all prospective candidate Doctors to apply for a PhD dissertation to be submitted.
2. Holders of a Master's degree awarded by either a Greek or Foreign University are accepted on condition that their papers closely address the relevance and quality of studies of the department at issue, following the judgment of the University's department committee in charge. An exception could be made with those who do not hold a Master's Degree, as long as they comply with the department's prerequisites (see Postgraduate Studies Programme).
3. Interested parties should submit the following documents until **June 25, 2012** to the Registry of the Department of Biology, University of Crete (Biology UoC), Voutes, Heraklion:
 - An application form specifying the title and topic of the PhD thesis to be submitted.
 - Letter of acceptance from a Faculty Member of Biology, UoC.
 - A certified copy of both First and Master's Degrees. In case the latter is still pending when submitting the documents, candidates accepted for PhD studies are kindly required to submit it by the end of March the latest.
 - A Certificate from DOATAP www.doatap.gr for candidate graduates from universities abroad.
 - A complete Curriculum Vitae including data on education, research or professional activity, potential scientific work and candidates' interests.
 - A report related to the reasons for the PhD thesis at issue.
 - Certified copies of diplomas of sufficient knowledge of English or other foreign languages. Certified copies of diplomas of sufficient knowledge of English and Greek for those who are foreigners.
 - Two letters of recommendation directly sent to the Faculty Member who supervises the student.
 - Declaration (according to the L. 1599/86) that the student is not enrolled in a graduate program of another Department.
