WHAT IS ON OFFER?

This is an international Joint Masters Degree in AquaCulture, Environment and Society (ACES) and you will be based in 3 Universities in Scotland, Crete and France. The full time, 2 year course is explicitly targeted at highly talented international students with Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in one of the fields of environmental or social sciences, who wish to advance their skills, particularly with a transnational focus. The top applicants to the course will be considered for an Erasmus Plus (previously 'Mundus') scholarship.

ERASMUS PLUS SCHOLARSHIPS

A limited number of Erasmus Plus Scholarships are available on a competitive basis for each intake to cover the tuition fees, living and travel expenses. Application from EU and particularly non-EU candidates are welcome.

WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

Tuition fees (for non-scholarship holders): 4,500 €/year for European Students and 9,000 €/year for all other students. All students may apply for Erasmus Plus Scholarships.
