

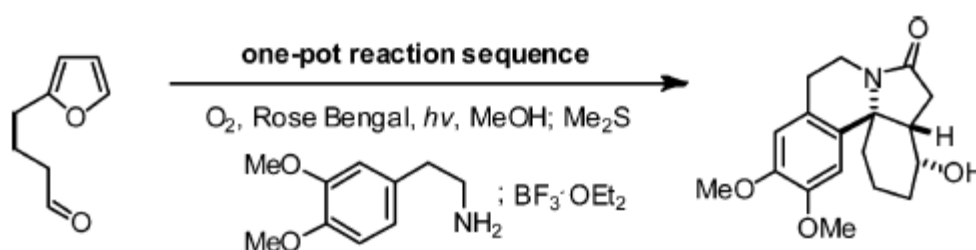


Invitation to an Open Workshop on
