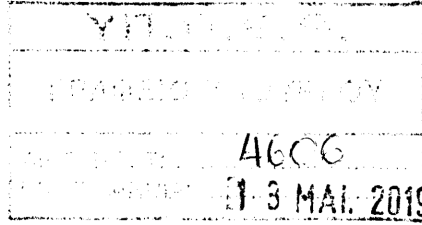

The Embassy of India presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic and has the honor to state that Jawaharlal Nehru University, (JNU), Delhi, a leading Indian university, is looking for a Visiting Scholar at the level of Professor or Associate Professor for the Greek Chair at its School of Language, Literature and Cultural Studies. The Chair, established in 1999, was last occupied by a Greek scholar, Prof. Andreas L. Katonis, from March 2015 until December 2018. It has been vacant following Prof. Katonis' resignation last December.

The Embassy shall be grateful for the Ministry's kind assistance in dissemination of information regarding the vacancy, among the leading Greek universities, for soliciting an appropriate candidate from Greece. The Professor will be required to organise/undertake teaching and research programme in Greek Studies, which may include Classical and Modern Greek Language, Literature, Philosophy, Culture and History. The position is for a period of one year, extendable, by mutual consent, up to two years. Under para 5 of the Agreement between the Government of the Hellenic Republic and the Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, of June 1999 (copy attached) " The Jawaharlal Nehru University shall, through the Indian Embassy in Athens, and in consultation with the Embassy of Greece in India, search for a Scholar to occupy this Chair". The monthly remuneration will be paid by JNU according to the qualifications and current status of the scholar. It will also provide two-way airfares for the scholar and his/her spouse, and free furnished accommodation. Since the academic session in JNU commences in July every year, the new incumbent needs to take up the Greek Chair in advance.

The Embassy of India avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic the assurances of its highest consideration.

Agreement between the Government of the Hellenic Republic
and
Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, India

Subject : Establishment of a Chair in Classical Greek Studies in the School of Language, Literature and Culture Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi.

This Agreement is drawn up between the Government of the Hellenic Republic through H.E. the Ambassador of the Hellenic Republic in India and Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) to set up a Chair in Classical Greek Studies in the School of Language, Literature and Culture Studies, JNU, New Delhi, India.

Objective :

The objective of setting up this Chair is to introduce and promote at JNU the study of Classical and Modern Greek Language, Literature, History, Philosophy and Culture.


To enable this :

1. The Government of the Hellenic Republic shall make a one time endowment grant of US \$ one hundred thousand.
2. From the interest accruing on the endowment grant, the University would pay at the current Indian rate the maximum of Professor's / Associate Professor's / Assistant Professor's salary according to the status of the Scholar who occupies the Chair.
3. The University will also provide free furnished accommodation on the campus to the Scholar holding the Chair.
4. The University shall also pay to the Scholar, and his spouse, airfare to take up the assignment and to return to Greece at the end of the assignment. If the assignment is for more than one year, the Scholar and his spouse will be provided two-way airfare for term holidays after one year.


5. The Jawaharlal Nehru University shall, through the Indian Embassy in Athens, and in consultation with the Embassy of Greece in India, search for a Scholar to occupy this Chair.
6. The Scholar selected to occupy this Chair shall hold the position for a period of one year, extendable by mutual consent, to two years.
7. The first Scholar to take the Chair may join JNU in the beginning of July 1999.

This Agreement will come into effect on the day it is signed by the Ambassador on behalf of the Government of the Hellenic Republic and the Vice Chancellor on behalf of Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, India.
