The Academic Liaison Committee of the Medical School, IMBB-FORTH, UCRC is organizing the Regenerative Medicine Day at July 27th, 2022, as part of the Regenerative Medicine Month. The scientific program of the day includes a panel discussion on research, translational, clinical and ethical aspects of Regenerative Medicine. Also, oral and poster presentations from Researches in the field of Regenerative Medicine will be integrated in the program to facilitate networking and interactions among all participants.

The Organizing Committee is soliciting abstracts for oral and poster presentations and we are inviting postdoctoral researchers, PhD and MSc students to submit their abstracts, indicating their preference for an oral presentation (upon selection). The deadline for submission is *May 23, 2022*.

Abstract Submission Information

Title

• The title of the abstract should be short and clear.

Authors

• The names of the authors follow in lower case. The first name should precede with the initial letter only (eg D. Papadopoulos).

- In another line, mention the affiliation of each author.
- In case of multiple affiliations, use separate numbers 1, 2, 3, etc., written as follows:
 - After each name, e.g. D. Papadopoulos¹, A. Dimou²
 - Before each affiliation, e.g. ¹Center of Origin A, ²Center Origin B.

Summary Text and Figure/Table

• The body of the summary (mainly text and 1 figure/table maximum) should not exceed 500 words.

• The text of the Summary should be written in the following order:

a) Purpose of the study, b) Material and Method, c) Results and d) Conclusions.
